

What Is Prostate Cancer?

Prostate Cancer is a cancer that starts in the prostate gland in which tumours grow in the malignant, prostate gland either slowly (most common) or fast and aggressively (can be life-threatening if not treated accordingly).

It is the most common cancer in men. 1 in 8 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in their lifetime and 1 in 30 men will die from it.

What Are The Treatment Options Available For Those Diagnosed With Prostate Cancer?

It is important to recognize what the best treatment option(s) will be for you as prostate cancer treatment options depend on many factors.

The three most important factors are:

1. The type and stage of the cancer
2. The grade or Gleason score
3. Prostate-Specific Antigen (PSA) levels
